School Reorganisation Proposal – Establishment of a Learning Resource Base at Caerleon Lodge Hill Primary School – Final Determination

Options Considered/Reasons for Decision

This school re-organisation proposal was carried out in accordance with the statutory School Organisation Code and included a formal consultation period followed by the publication of a statutory notice for the required period of 28 days.

The consultation passed through the statutory notice stage without objection and therefore a final decision can now be taken by the Leader of the Council.
